but not St. Snyder.

I was sick and my
doctor sent me to New
Orleans to see another
Dr to have an spray
of my lungs made and
there is nothing wrong
with them. The only
thing they find is low
blood and nervous
break down. They say I
worry too much. How can
any one help it. I feel
much better now.

How are those sweet

you have can you send
me one. Send one of you
and Lt Snyder too. I have
his with the crew but
if you have another spare
me one.

Mrs Snyder I received
some letters from ~~2~~ Mrs
Anstee and her daughter
from England. They are so
sweet. They told me Louis
use to spend all his days
off at their home in
Bedford. The way I can
see the girl was in love
with Louis. They got my
address from a picture
that Louis gave them.
