I received your letter just as I started to eat my dinner, I was so glad I ran to my sister's and mother's house where I came back I forgot to finish eating. My mother was so glad she cried. I still think I hear from my darling, I went to town right after I got your

you wrote me. I am
receiving insurance
already. I have that
six month pay and
they paid me for
eight months of
insurance already. I
received \$842.40 for that
six month pay and
one check for insurance
for \$310.10 in one lump
sum. And in all, I
have already received
\$1196.80. I used some
to go to a doctor in
New Orleans and I put
the rest for a payment

back. If he comes
back it is his.

Mrs Snyder I went to
a doctor in New Orleans
for lung x-rays. I had
lost so much weight
but there isn't any
thing wrong with my
lungs. I am just run
down and nervous.
I have gained four
pounds. I worry too much.
I feel better now.

Mrs Snyder I am so
glad you sent me that
picture. I showed it to
all my family & friends.
I am so glad to hear from you.

I was so worried about your husband and the rest of those poor boys. I thought they had bailed out over the channel and drowned.

Miss Snyder I get Berlin on my radio and every night I write to some families that they name their prisoners. One mother had two missing, but it is now two weeks I can't get Berlin. We are giving them the best food - all
